## Instructor Supplies – Beautiful Beasts

### Instructor Supplies

Michael will be supplying ALL the paint and the Two Part Clay. A material fee of \$25.00 will provide each student with golden paints and clay. The material fee will be collected on the first day of the workshop.

#### Included in the kit fee:

1. Aves (Two Part Clay)
2. Acrylic Paint
3. Dremels, Drills and Tools
4. Acrylic Latex Caulking

#### Student Supplies

1. Animal toys, statues, or figurines.

  - Collage Tools
  - Mark making tools
  - Portfolio Pastels
