

Supply List

Instructor Supplies – The Sordid Chronicles of Shady Characters

Michael will be providing a variety of supplies included in your registration fee.

Student Supplies

Students should provide the following supplies:

1. A box or case for your stage. Could be a hollowed out radio or a jewelry box etc. Your characters will be somewhere between 2"-6" so whatever size characters you want to create will determine the box size (they have to fit inside)
2. A variety of found objects. Items like watch parts, gears, typewriter parts – juust about anything, really. Look for things that are interesting shapes or designs. Tiny doll parts.
3. Bits of fabric for clothing. Dark or black ideally.
4. Paint Brushes (a couple small detail brushes, and some cheap brushes (1/2 inch to 1 inch in size)
5. E 6000 Adhesive
6. Eyes or things that might replicate eyes. Tiny doll eyes would be great.
7. Optional Things to bring – Heat gun, Dremel (with cut off wheel and engraving bit, sanding drum
8. A couple of pieces of primed canvas. 8"x10" ish. These will be the backdrop of your scene so just figure something that will cover the back of your box.

Instructor Supplies – Grifters and Gumshoes

Andrea will provide the following supplies for a \$25 kit fee. Fee will be collected on-site.

- Illustration Board Substrate (approx size 15”X20”)
- Use of all Golden Paints and Mediums
- A package of Film Noir Images
- Use of stencils
- Use of Portfolio Pastels

Students should provide the following supplies:

- A few of your favourite Film Noir images (actors, buildings, titles, etc...) Your class kit will include several of these as well so need to go overboard with this.
- Paintbrushes– bring just a few in different sizes and one better quality detail brush.
- Palette & Water Container
- Golden Matte medium –8 oz. (when you shake the bottle it should sound like it has the consistency of syrup, not mayonnaise)
- Scissors
- Your usual marking making tools (pencils, markers, etc.)
