Supplies – Dante's Infernal Journal

Instructor Supplies

Michael will be supplying ALL paint, glue and clay.

Student Supplies

1. Exacto Knife
2. Book Form: Two Options:
Exterior Only – A hardback art journal or hardback book (could be a copy of Dante's Inferno) that you want to modify. The innards will be untouched.
Interior and Exterior- A book box (the boxes made to look like books)
3. Foam Board or Matte Board (only necessarily if working on the interior)- enough to cut 8 or more pieces the same size as the book
4. Books, Magazines, and other paper ephemera
5. Various small found objects: not a bad idea to bring a small cigar box full of watch parts, decorative elements etc.
6. Brushes – small to medium bristle brushes and few detail/liner brushes
